## SALT LAKE COUNTY PHASE 33 EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM FEMA (EFSP) (RFP)

The State Community Services Office (SCSO) is accepting applications from emergency food and shelter organizations in Salt Lake County for Phase 33 Emergency Food and Shelter Program FEMA (EFSP). The Phase 33 funding period has not been finalized, but may include the period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 OR January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016.

Under the terms of the grant from the National Board, local agencies chosen to receive funds must: 1) be private voluntary non-profits or units of government; 2) have an accounting system; 3) practice nondiscrimination; 4) have demonstrated the capability to deliver emergency food and/or shelter programs and 5) if they are a private voluntary organization, they must have a voluntary board. Qualifying agencies are urged to apply in anticipation of receiving the final Phase 33 EFSP award notice from the national EFSP Board.
