




Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate JUNE 2016

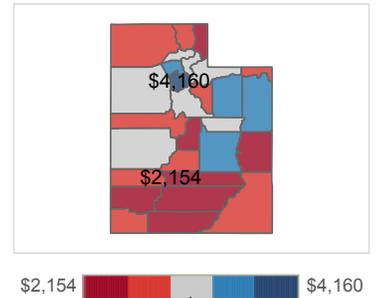



Initial Claims for Unemployment Insurance

Unemployment and Wages

Juab County's unemployment rate in June remained unchanged at 4.1 percent.



In June, an estimated 213 individuals were unemployed while an estimated 4,968 employed Juab residents were either working within the county or commuting to work outside the area.



The average monthly wage increased 3.7 percent in the first quarter of 2016 relative to the previous year.


Construction Permitting JANUARY-MARCH 2016

Dwelling Unit Permits







Year-to-Year Change In Gross Taxable Sales FIRST QUARTER 2016





Construction and Sales

Juab had 8 new dwelling unit permits from January to March 2016, a decrease of 27 percent compared to 2015. 🏠

Construction averaged 394 jobs in the first quarter of 2016 compared to 322 a year-ago, an increase of 22 percent. 🏠

The total permitted value of construction from January to March 2016 was \$2.3 million, down from \$3.6 million in 2015. 🏠

Taxable sales in Juab County totaled \$25.1 million in first quarter 2016, an increase of 6 percent relative to last year. 💰

- * This selection creates a portable document file.

- * Each tab in the visualization is formatted to create an 8.5 by 11 inch pdf file.
- * You can also download individual files.
